SUBJECT: SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS – APRIL 2017

Attached is the statistical report for the Santa Clarita Public Library for April 2017.

Overall statistics for the Santa Clarita Public Library in April 2017 include:

- 58,758 patrons visited the Libraries, 1,023 new Library cards were issued, and 4,795 patrons attended a Library program.
- 98,944 books and materials were circulated, and 9,924 holds were filled.
- 10,710 patrons reserved and used a public computer, while 4,867 patrons used the Library’s free Wi-Fi.
- The Library’s website received 43,958 visits, comprising 22,726 new visitors and 21,232 returning visitors. Together they viewed 63,260 website pages on the Library website.

***Santa Clarita Public Library April 2017 Programs and Highlights***

Regularly scheduled programs for April included: Baby Toddler Storytime, Just for 2's and 3's Storytime, Bilingual Storytime, School Readiness Storytime, Saturday Family Storytime, Homework Help, LEGO Party, Board games, Digital Drop-In, and The Wednesday Club.

In addition, the following programs also took place in April:

- **Dia de Los Niños/Dia de los Libros (Childrens Day/Book Day)** – On April 29, over 700 people celebrated this program at the Canyon Country Library, which included the SCV Chinese School teaching children how to say ‘panda’ in Chinese, and a performance from Ballet Folklórico. In addition, there was face painting, paper bag puppets, watercolor painting, therapy dogs, and a llama. The neighboring restaurants also participated by selling food in the parking lot. Every child who attended was also given a free book, compliments of the Friends of the Library.



**Computer Training** – On Saturday, April 29, the Old Town Newhall Library hosted a free computer class on JavaScript II. JavaScript is an object-oriented computer programming language commonly used to create interactive effects within web browsers. Programming languages like JavaScript are crucial in building rich HTML web pages, such as animated graphics, interactive maps or scrolling videos. This class is part of the system-wide Digital Literacy Program, which offers a variety of free computer and technology classes for adults.

- **Climate Change Documentary** – The Santa Clarita Public Library hosted “Witnessing Climate Change Firsthand: Three Films by National Geographic” in honor of Earth Month in April. The free film series was organized by The Citizens’ Climate Lobby/Citizens’ Climate Education, Santa Clarita Chapter, a grassroots advocacy organization that focusses on national policies to address climate change. Three documentaries were shown over the course of three consecutive Tuesdays at the Valencia Library, including the full-length film, “Before the Flood,” narrated by Leonardo DiCaprio. Each of the events drew an audience of approximately 25 people.
