SUBJECT: SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS – MAY 2017

Attached is the statistical report for the Santa Clarita Public Library for May 2017.

Overall statistics for the Santa Clarita Public Library in May 2017 include:

- 60,805 patrons visited the Libraries, 877 new Library cards were issued, and 3,060 patrons attended a Library program.
- 96,579 books and materials were circulated, and 9,525 holds were filled.
- 11,279 patrons reserved and used a public computer, while 4,963 patrons used the Library's free Wi-Fi.
- The Library's website received 46,699 visits, comprising 24,143 new visitors and 22,556 returning visitors. Together they viewed 69,639 website pages on the Library website.

 Community Outreach – On May 26, a library staff member from the Digital Branch was off-site at a community event to talk about library resources and issue library cards. The audience of around 30 people was primarily made up of entrepreneurs, small business owners, and people trying to create their own start-ups. A live demo of the library business resource Mergent Intellect was provided, which allows businesses to research industry forecasts, explore demographics by region or zip code, build competitor reports, and create potential customer lists for distribution.
