
2020 SANTA CLARITA SMALL BUSINESS COVID RELIEF GRANT

General Information



BACKGROUND

The 2020 Santa Clarita Small Business COVID Relief Grant program is intended to provide small businesses financial reimbursements for expenses incurred from business interruption due to COVID-19 impacts. Expenses must have been incurred between March 1, 2020, and December 30, 2020 with receipts provided to the City prior to reimbursement.

THIS ONE-TIME FINANCIAL REIMBURSEMENT IS EXCLUSIVELY FOR COSTS RELATED TO:

- Personal protective equipment, such as masks, gloves, face shields, disposable gowns, and shoe covers
- Cleaning and sanitizing products
- Equipment related to remote working and distance learning
- Physical space modification to allow social distancing indoors as well as expand activities outdoors to continue business operations safely according to current health order guidelines
- Adaptive business services: services needed for your business to stay open while health order restrictions are in place. These include but are not limited to: disinfecting services increased sanitation to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and alternative disinfection procedures, such as ultrasonic waves, high intensity UV radiation, and LED blue light methods against COVID-19virus.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL BUSINESSES INCLUDE:

- Must have been in operation for at least one (1) year as October 1, 2019
- Must have 100 employees or less
- Must be located in a commercial property located in the City of Santa Clarita or within the unincorporated areas
- Must not have any existing, non-resolved code violations as identified in a formal notice from the City of Santa Clarita.
- Pledges to take the <u>Safer Business Commitment</u> to follow the latest safety guidelines and best practices, as issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to continue slowing the spread of COVID-19
