In addition to looking for opportunities to add parks, it is also a City priority to enhance existing parks. This can be seen in the new inclusive play area at West Creek Park featured on the cover of


this Seasons magazine. Following the ground-breaking last August, the playground area has been completely revamped with play equipment suitable for people of all abilities. Learn more about the new play area on pages 6-7.

The crown jewel of our park system, Central Park, is currently under construction on the southern side of the site. This buildout project is bringing four new fields, with more restrooms, parking and enhancements to our dog park. For parents looking to get in a workout while their children are at sports practice – the project also includes a 172-step exercise staircase.

Other exciting new parks projects include a second bike park in the Haskell Canyon Open Space, enhancements at David March Park, expanding Canyon Country Park and a new park at Via Princessa is in the planning phase.

# State of the City 2025 Strategic Plan

The City is looking back at all of the accomplishments which were achieved during year two of the Santa Clarita 2025 (SC 2025) Strategic Plan. The plan is divided



into **seven themes** that best synthesize our organization's essential work areas.

Under the theme of **Building and Creating Community**, the City contributed an additional
\$2 million to Bridge to Home for the construction
of a permanent homeless shelter. We also
welcomed new programs including: Senior

Softball, Bingo and Pokeno for teens and seniors, Adaptive Aquatics Swim Lessons, the new "I Can Craft" program for adults with special needs, the Pop-Up & Play summer series and 54 new contract classes.

To increase Community Engagement, the City launched the "Celebrate" cultural series

at the Canyon Country Community Center. The six events took place each month from April to September, showcasing cultures, customs and culinary wonders from the Polynesian Islands, our Sister Cities in Ecuador and the Philippines, India, Greece, the Caribbean and Mexico. Santa Clarita also held the first "Free to Be Me" festival to celebrate our differently-abled residents and their families with inclusive and adaptive activities.





For the theme of **Sustaining Public Infrastructure**, the City maintained and rehabilitated a total of 90-lane miles of road as part of the 2021-22 Annual Overlay and Slurry Seal project. Our parks also got some upkeep as we resurfaced the basketball courts at Fair Oaks Park and Valencia Summit Park, replaced playground surfacing at Newhall Park, completed extensive renovations to the Plum Canyon Park ballfield, improved the park entrance

and created a new picnic area at Creekview Park and improved the T-ball field at Bridgeport Park.

Under the theme of **Enhancing Economic Vitality**, the City attracted large-scale events such as Spartan's L.A. Sprint Weekend and

Boots and Brews featuring Brad Paisley, to promote tourism and increase economic benefit to Santa Clarita and local businesses.

Santa Clarita remains a beautiful place to live, work and play thanks to the theme of **Community Beautification and Sustainability**. Under this theme, the City hosted the first ever Graffiti Removal Day with volunteers completing a large-scale beautification project in the Saugus community. To help residents get around in a clean, green way – the City purchased two new Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) powered commuter buses and four new CNG powered local transit buses.

Santa Clarita is regularly ranked as one of the safest cities in the nation thanks to the



work under our theme of **Public Safety**. The Santa Clarita Valley Sheriff's Department and the City work hand in hand to educate the community about crime prevention and also conduct data-driven strategic operations, including operations related to grand theft auto and theft of catalytic converters.

# III EALDS DISCONNECT FROM DISTRACTIONS.

Taking a few extra moments to ensure you are safe when driving a vehicle can mean the difference between a normal day and one with life-changing consequences. In the City of Santa Clarita, traffic safety continues to be of utmost importance to ensure our roads and trails are safe for all users — drivers, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians.

When you **Disconnect from Distractions**, Expect People (and Cars) in Crosswalks and commit to See and Be Seen, you take the necessary steps to not only reduce the number of collisions that happen in Santa Clarita but also reduce the severity of injuries that occur. Together, we can make Santa Clarita streets safer for all.

**Disconnecting from Distractions** can be difficult, especially when scrambling to get your kids to their activities on time. However, distracted driving diverts your attention and slows your reaction time behind the wheel. According to the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety's annual Culture Index, more than 95 percent of respondents surveyed view reading or typing a message on a cell phone while driving to be dangerous. With that statistic in mind, it is alarming to find that nearly a quarter of respondents also say they've driven while typing or sending a text or email at least once in the past 30 days and more than a third say they drive while talking or reading on a handheld cell phone.

Pedestrians who are distracted by their phones or listening to music reduce their ability to see and hear approaching traffic and emergency vehicles. They may also fail to properly check that crosswalks are clear before crossing the street.

Speaking of crosswalks, it is always best to assume that someone — a pedestrian, cyclist or vehicle — will be at every crosswalk you encounter. By expecting others at intersections, you give yourself ample time to react and greatly reduce the likelihood of being involved in a collision.

Another traffic safety tip that can help save lives is to See and Be Seen. When you are out riding your bicycle, walking with your family to the local park or driving home from work at the end of the day, you want to make sure that others on the road can see you — and that you can see them. Make sure your headlights are working properly, wear high-visibility clothing if you are a cyclist or pedestrian and make predictable movements so that your intentions are clear.

### **VOLUNTEER IMPACT:**

- Contributed to the success of various events, including Party on the Pointe, Eggstravaganza, Light Up Main Street, Zombie Run, Halloween Fiesta and Haunted House, Thanksgiving community dinners, Dia de los Libros and Family Literacy Festival, among others
- Made the City of Santa Clarita the first agency to have completed its section of the new Crest-to-Coast Trail and provided a crucial connection to dozens of trails in SCV
- Removed 11,320 pounds of trash from the Santa Clara River during River Rally
- Built over five miles of new trails, maintained over 25 miles of trails at various Open Space properties, and built the new Roving **Archery Range**
