SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS - OCTOBER 2015

Attached is the statistical report for the Santa Clarita Public Library for October 2015.

Overall statistics for the Santa Clarita Public Library branches in October 2015 include:

- 80,295 patrons visited the Libraries, 1,187 new Library cards were issued, and 6,230 patrons attended a Library program.
- 121,384 books and materials were circulated, and 12,826 holds were filled.
- 16,207 patrons reserved and used a public computer, while 5,487 patrons used the Library's free Wi-Fi.
- The Library's website received 53,225 visits, comprising 24,803 new visitors and 28,422 returning visitors. Together they viewed 88,604 website pages on the Library website.

Santa Clarita Public Library October 2015 Programs and Highlights

Autumn programming for Santa Clarita Public Library continued in October. Regularly scheduled programs for Fall included: Storytimes for Baby and Toddler, Just 2s and 3s, School Readiness, Bilingual/Cuenta Cuentos, Pajama, and Elementary, Youth Chess Club, Lego Days, Read to Dogs, and Homework Help.

In addition to the regularly scheduled storytimes and programs, the following Fall programs took place:

• Kitchen Science – School-age children had a chance to try simple experiments during the Kitchen Science programs at the Old Town Newhall Library. During this month's program, Lava Lunacy, children made predictions and learned about mixing liquids with different densities. Each child performed an experiment using water, oil, liquid food coloring, and Alka-Seltzer tablets. A small flashlight was used to light the bottles of solution from below once the Alka-Seltzer was added, creating an impromptu Lava Lamp.




- All Staff Day All Staff Day 2015 focused on Emergency Preparedness. In the beginning of the day, staff were divided into Survivor Teams to decide what items would ensure their survival in the event of a devastating (but humorous) disaster. Donna Nuzzi, Emergency Services Supervisor, gave an informative presentation, and Darren Hernàndez inspired the group with his vision for the Library. After lunch, everyone went to their respective libraries for a Hazard Mitigation Hunt and evacuation drills.
- Teen Read Week Santa Clarita Public Library celebrated Teen Read Week, a national literacy initiative created by Young Adult Library Services Association (YALSA), by embracing the theme of "Get Away at Your Library." Through compelling displays featuring books set in each of the 50 states, blog posts spotlighting titles from around the world, and songs for a road trip, librarians highlighted recreational resources that allow teens to travel to far-off places without leaving the comfort of their own city. To encourage teens to capture their own adventures, each branch hosted a craft program where teens could repurpose old maps as photo frames.

- Kid Expo Staff from the Santa Clarita Public Library made Library cards, shared information about free story times and events the Library has to offer, and answered questions families had about the Library. The Expo table was dedicated to Legos so staff could highlight the many Lego programs that are offered. Staff is proud to participate in events like Kid Expo where they can make new friends in the community and give a hearty, outside-the-library hello to all the families they already know and love.
- Halloween Scavenger Hunt This event encouraged children to explore their local Library branch in a fun and seasonal way. By earning a reward for searching out spooky decorations hidden around the children's area, families learned how to navigate the various sections of the Library together and become more familiar on how to find books, movies, and resources to enjoy. By creating a silly atmosphere through costumes and crafts, children were able to practice fine motor skills and self-expression, promoting an early interest in the Library.
- Adult Adaptive On the first Friday of each month, Santa Clarita Library offers a program for differently abled adults and their caregivers at the Canyon Country branch. Adult Adaptive Reading program offers a chance to explore new titles, learn something new, and socialize. October's event was all about Superheroes! They practiced drawing superheroes, read graphic novels, and tested their technical skills with a Batman computer game.








SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 CIRCULATION









5,363 patrons used public computers in the Canyon Country Library, 7,060 in Newhall Library, and 3,784 in Valencia Library.










SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 HOLDS FILLED

3,871 holds were filled in the Canyon Country Library, 3,302 in Newhall Library, and 5,653 in Valencia Library.










SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 PROGRAM ATTENDANCE

1,609 attended a Library program at the Canyon Country Library, 2,882 at Newhall Library, and 1,739 at Valencia Library.










SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 LIBRARY CARDS ISSUED

347 new Library cards were issued at the Canyon Country Library, 536 at Newhall Library, and 304 at Valencia Library.










SANTA CLARITA PUBLIC LIBRARY STATISTICS FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 WI-FI USERS

In October 2015, the Library's website received a total of 53,225 visits.

28,422 were returning visitors and 24,803 were new visitors to the Library website.

Visitors to the Santa Clarita Public Library website viewed 88,604 website pages during the month of October 2015.
